2 RECOGNIZING THE BLUE BUTTERFLY AS A SYMBOL TO BRING AWARENESS  
3 TO HUNTINGTON'S DISEASE.

5 WHEREAS, Huntington's disease is a rare inherited  
6 disease that attacks areas of the brain that control  
7 voluntary movement, balance, walking and cognitive  
8 functioning; and

9 WHEREAS, the blue butterfly is recognized as a symbol of  
10 awareness and hope for a cure for those with Huntington's  
11 disease; and

12 WHEREAS, the Huntington's disease blue butterfly symbol  
13 has been pictured with the slogan "We Don't Know How Strong  
14 We Are Until Being Strong Is The Only Choice We Have";

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
16 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the blue  
17 butterfly be recognized as a symbol of awareness and hope for  
18 people with Huntington's disease; and
