## **March 2017 Quarterly Update**

#### **Ouarterly Status of Outstanding Capital Funds**

- As of March 2017, approximately \$855.2 million from all funding sources for 2,297 projects remains outstanding including \$102.2 million of earmarked fund balances for water (\$43 million), colonias (\$29.7 million), and tribal (\$29.6 million) infrastructure projects; approximately \$302.5 million remains outstanding from supplemental severance tax bonds for public schools.
- The March quarterly report includes 148 projects totaling \$174.3 million funded by general obligation bond issues approved by voters in November 2016. The bonds are typically sold in March or April, but the Board of Finance has delayed the bond issuance and may not sell until late summer, 2017.
- On January 27, 2017, the executive issued a capital outlay freeze for projects appropriated prior to 2016 with no activity. No activity was defined to include projects without a Notice of Obligation and projects with no encumbrances or expenditures as of January 23, 2017. Sixteen projects totaling approximately \$24.2 million on the \$1 million or greater report and local outstanding report are on hold due to the capital outlay freeze.
- Since the December 2016 quarterly report, 198 projects closed and approximately \$114.4 million was expended or reverted.
- Percentage of outstanding funding sources: general fund (GF) .2 percent, severance tax bonds (STB) 23.4 percent, general obligation bonds (GOB) 47.4 percent, and other state funds (OSF) 29 percent.

- LFC staff tracks all \$1 million or greater capital appropriations totaling nearly \$1.3 billion for 254 projects. The unexpended balances for projects \$1 million or greater total \$686.4 million, or 80.3 percent, of all unexpended funds. Since the December 2016 report, 4 appropriations totaling \$9 million were fully expended. One project totaling \$5 million, appropriated in 2016 for pre-kindergarten classrooms, was swept during the 2017 Legislative Session.
- **Note**: Data for quarterly and \$1 million or greater reports is derived from the Capital Project Monitoring System operated and maintained by the Department of Finance and Administration. Data is updated quarterly by state agencies and local entities responsible for oversight of the projects and includes expenditures, project status, milestones achieved last quarter and projected milestones. ### **<u>2014 Water Initiative Status</u>** (Attachment A)


- \$83.5 million was authorized for 191 water projects statewide in the 2014 capital outlay bill. Of the 191 water projects funded, over half have been completed (102 projects).
- Nearly \$35 million, or 41.4 percent, remains unexpended. Of the unexpended balance, 15 projects totaling \$10.9 million have no expenditures.
- 24 projects totaling \$1.9 million were deauthorized during the 2016 special session due to inactivity.
- Since funds were appropriated, 13 projects totaling \$9.5 million have been reauthorized to change the purpose or extend time.

### **Authorized but Unissued Status (Attachment B)**

- Following the December 6, 2016 bond sale, 53 projects authorized for \$19.7 million remain unissued.
- Due to noncompliance with audit requirement, 18 entities in 11 counties are "ineligible" for bond issuance resulting in 19 projects totaling \$1.3 million being stalled.
- Due to anti-donation issues, 10 entities in 8 counties are "ineligible" for bond issuance resulting in 11 projects totaling approximately \$1 million being stalled.

# 2014 Water Initiative Status Update Third Quarter, Fiscal Year 2017

Nearly \$35 million of 2014 capital outlay appropriations for water storage, delivery, and treatment projects remains unspent; \$4.65 million was expended in the third quarter of FY17. Water was the primary focus of the 2014 capital outlay bill which funded 191 water projects at a cost \$83.5 million. As of March 2017, \$10.85 million was dedicated to 15 projects that had not drawn a penny from the appropriation, down from \$12.2 million at the end of the second quarter. Additionally, \$34.6 million, or 41.4 percent, was unspent, down from nearly \$40 million and 49 percent at the end of the second quarter. Over half of the projects are completed, and the number of closeouts declined in the third quarter. In the nearly three years since the funds were appropriated, 13 projects totaling \$9.5 million have been reauthorized to change the purpose or extend the time to spend the funds beyond the original four year period. These reauthorized appropriations still have a total balance of \$7.1 million. Additionally, funding for 24 projects totaling \$1.9 million was de-authorized during the 2016 special session due to inactivity.

The Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD) received \$6.2 million for forest thinning and watershed restoration and has made significant progress in spending the funds by taking a proactive approach and setting up grant agreements and working with other partners before the funds were received. To date, the agency has spent all but \$148 thousand of the appropriation.

Nearly three-quarters of the projects are for local entities and are overseen by the Environment Department (NMED). At the July 2016 Legislative Finance Committee meeting in Ruidoso, NMED officials stated much of the slow progress was due to the fact that many of the projects did not have complete plans or designs when the funds were appropriated. Almost half of the projects overseen by NMED are complete, 9 projects totaling \$6.7 million are inactive, and 18 projects that received just over \$1 million were de-authorized during the special legislative session in 2016.

Only 3 of 22 appropriations greater than \$1 million have closed, including \$1.4 million for water system improvements in Rio Rancho, \$2 million for the first phase of a sanitary sewer system in Carnuel, and \$1.9 million to expand a wastewater treatment facility in Los Lunas. Of the \$58.2 million appropriated to large projects, three have yet to begin expending funds, including two projects for the Camino Real Regional Utility Authority totaling \$5.45 million. The largest appropriations, a combined \$8 million for a wastewater treatment plant in Chama, had progressed slowly; however, the project is now in construction, over \$5 million has been expended in FY17, and it is expected to be complete by October 2017.

Of the 24 deauthorized projects, six that had received a total of \$280 thousand were in Rio Arriba County. No other county had more than two deauthorized projects. The largest deauthorized appropriations were \$400 thousand for improvements to San Mateo Dam in Cibola County and \$300 thousand to improve Cimarroncito Dam in Colfax County.
