**56TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2024**

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR  
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,  
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND  
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF  
UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE  
IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section  
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds  
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been  
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax  
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or  
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously  
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is  
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been  
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax  
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the  
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--  
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section  
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation  
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the  
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the  
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation  
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date  
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this  
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general  
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A  
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the  
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs  
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a  
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo  
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the  
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2           **SECTION 3. ATRISCO VISTA BOULEVARD CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND**  
3 **TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the  
4 department of transportation project in Subsection 1 of Section  
5 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to acquire rights of way for and  
6 to plan, design, construct, extend and improve Atrisco Vista  
7 boulevard, including bike lanes, in Bernalillo county is  
8 extended through fiscal year 2026.

9           **SECTION 4. BERNALILLO COUNTY SOUTH VALLEY FAMILY SERVICES**  
10 **FACILITY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY--CHANGE TO FACILITY**  
11 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended  
12 balance of the appropriation to the local government division  
13 originally authorized in Subsection 53 of Section 26 of Chapter  
14 80 of Laws 2018 and reauthorized in Laws 2022, Chapter 52,  
15 Section 8 to plan, design and construct renovations and  
16 improvements to the buildings and grounds of a child  
17 development and family services facility site in the South  
18 Valley in Bernalillo county and to purchase and install  
19 teleconferencing and information technology equipment at  
20 facility sites in the South Valley and the southeast heights in  
21 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the  
22 original or reauthorized purpose but is changed to plan,  
23 design, construct, replace and equip buildings, facilities and  
24 grounds at a child development and family services site in the  
25 South Valley in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is

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1 extended through fiscal year 2026.

2           **SECTION 5. BERNALILLO COUNTY GUTIERREZ-HUBBELL HOUSE**  
3 **IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of  
4 expenditure for the local government division project in  
5 Subsection 16 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,  
6 design, construct, equip and furnish site, accessibility and  
7 building improvements, including an addition to the main house,  
8 at the Gutierrez-Hubbell house open space in the traditional  
9 Pajarito village center in Bernalillo county is extended  
10 through fiscal year 2026.

11           **SECTION 6. BERNALILLO COUNTY RIO BRAVO PARK IMPROVEMENT--**  
12 **EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for  
13 the local government division project in Subsection 20 of  
14 Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan, design,  
15 construct, equip and furnish improvements, including to roads,  
16 drainage, trails, soccer fields, parking, bridges and  
17 circulation, at Rio Bravo park in Bernalillo county is extended  
18 through fiscal year 2026.

19           **SECTION 7. BERNALILLO COUNTY STREET FOOD EQUIPMENT**  
20 **PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of  
21 expenditure for the local government division project in  
22 Subsection 26 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to  
23 purchase, deliver, install and equip commercial equipment for a  
24 commissary kitchen for Bernalillo county food entrepreneurs for  
25 the street food institute in Bernalillo county is extended

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1 through fiscal year 2026.

2           **SECTION 8. GATEWOOD AVENUE SOUTHWEST IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND**  
3 **TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the  
4 department of transportation project in Subsection 4 of Section  
5 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to acquire rights of way and to  
6 plan, design and construct road and drainage improvements on  
7 Gatewood avenue SW from Bridge boulevard to Five Points road in  
8 the Atrisco community in Bernalillo county is extended through  
9 fiscal year 2026.

10           **SECTION 9. ISLETA BOULEVARD RIGHTS-OF-WAY ACQUISITION AND**  
11 **IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of  
12 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
13 Subsection 6 of Section 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
14 acquire rights of way for and to plan, design, construct and  
15 improve Isleta boulevard SW to the south of Rio Bravo boulevard  
16 SW in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

17           **SECTION 10. QUIET LANE SOUTHWEST ROAD AND DRAIN**  
18 **IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of  
19 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
20 Subsection 7 of Section 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
21 acquire rights of way and to plan, design and construct road  
22 and storm drainage improvements on Quiet lane SW from Goff  
23 boulevard to the end of the road in the Atrisco community and  
24 for other road projects in house district 14 in Bernalillo  
25 county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

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1           **SECTION 11. KIRTLAND AIR FORCE BASE GROUND WATER**

2           MONITORING WELL CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--  
 3           SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The department of environment project in  
 4           Subsection 2 of Section 21 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan,  
 5           design and construct a ground water monitoring well for the  
 6           Albuquerque-Bernalillo county water utility authority to  
 7           monitor ethylene dibromide contamination in the area of  
 8           Kirtland air force base in Bernalillo county may include  
 9           planning, designing and constructing ground water monitoring  
 10          wells throughout the Albuquerque-Bernalillo county water  
 11          utility authority service area in Bernalillo county. The time  
 12          of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2026.

13           **SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE-BERNALILLO COUNTY WATER UTILITY**

14          AUTHORITY GROUND WATER MONITOR WELL CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND  
 15          PURPOSE--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The department of environment  
 16          project in Subsection 1 of Section 22 of Chapter 53 of Laws  
 17          2022 to plan, design and construct ground water monitoring  
 18          wells in the area of the Kirtland air force base bulk fuel  
 19          facility site for the Albuquerque-Bernalillo county water  
 20          utility authority in Bernalillo county may include planning,  
 21          designing and constructing ground water monitoring wells  
 22          throughout the Albuquerque-Bernalillo county water utility  
 23          authority service area in Bernalillo county.

24           **SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE SIGN LANGUAGE ACADEMY BUS**

25          PURCHASE--CHANGE TO PORTABLE GARAGE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL

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1 FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the  
2 public education department in Subsection 4 of Section 16 of  
3 Chapter 199 of Laws 2023 to purchase and equip activity buses,  
4 including wheelchair lifts, for the Albuquerque sign language  
5 academy charter school in Bernalillo county shall not be  
6 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase a  
7 portable building for use as a garage at the Albuquerque sign  
8 language academy charter school. The time of expenditure is  
9 extended through fiscal year 2026.

10 SECTION 14. ALBUQUERQUE ADELANTE DEVELOPMENT CENTER  
11 EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLE PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX  
12 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government  
13 division project in Subsection 34 of Section 30 of Chapter 53  
14 of Laws 2022 to purchase and equip vehicles, furniture and  
15 equipment, including information technology, sanitation  
16 equipment and warehouse equipment, for an organization  
17 providing residential and adult daycare services and employment  
18 training and assistance for disadvantaged populations in  
19 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
20 year 2026.

21 SECTION 15. ALBUQUERQUE AFFORDABLE HOUSING CONSTRUCTION--  
22 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for  
23 the local government division project in Subsection 37 of  
24 Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to acquire land for and  
25 to plan, design and construct affordable housing and homeless

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1 facilities in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended  
 2 through fiscal year 2026.

3 SECTION 16. ALBUQUERQUE ALL FAITHS VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT  
 4 PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
 5 expenditure for the local government division project in  
 6 Subsection 39 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to  
 7 purchase and equip vehicles and to purchase and install  
 8 equipment and furnishings, including coronavirus-disease-2019-  
 9 safe office furniture, playground equipment and information  
 10 technology, including equipment and infrastructure, at a  
 11 facility promoting the healing of children in Albuquerque in  
 12 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

13 SECTION 17. ALBUQUERQUE BUSINESS INCUBATOR AND KITCHEN  
 14 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
 15 expenditure for the local government division project in  
 16 Subsection 46 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
 17 acquire property and to plan, design, construct, demolish,  
 18 renovate, improve, equip, furnish and install equipment for a  
 19 food business incubator and kitchen in the downtown area of  
 20 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
 21 year 2026.

22 SECTION 18. ALBUQUERQUE OPEN SPACE, PARKS AND TRAILS  
 23 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
 24 expenditure for the local government division project  
 25 originally authorized in Subsection 43 of Section 34 of Chapter  
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1 277 of Laws 2019 and reauthorized in Laws 2022, Chapter 52,  
2 Section 18 to acquire property for and to plan, design,  
3 construct and equip the Crestview bluff open space area, parks  
4 and trails in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended  
5 through fiscal year 2026.

6 SECTION 19. ALBUQUERQUE DISTRICT SIX ART CORRIDOR SAFETY  
7 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
8 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
9 Subsection 10 of Section 75 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,  
10 design, construct and improve pedestrian safety and access to  
11 businesses along the Albuquerque rapid transit corridor in city  
12 council district 6 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is  
13 extended through fiscal year 2026.

14 SECTION 20. ALBUQUERQUE DISTRICT SIX STREET LIGHTING  
15 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
16 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
17 Subsection 11 of Section 75 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,  
18 design, construct, purchase and install improvements and  
19 additions to street lighting in city council district 6 in  
20 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
21 year 2026.

22 SECTION 21. ALBUQUERQUE DISTRICT FIVE MEDIAN  
23 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
24 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
25 Subsection 9 of Section 38 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,

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1 design, construct, purchase and install irrigation and  
 2 landscaping of medians in city council district 5 in  
 3 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
 4 year 2026.

5           **SECTION 22. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE INDOOR SPORTS FACILITY**  
 6 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO INDOOR SPORTS COMPLEX--EXTEND TIME--  
 7 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the  
 8 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection  
 9 108 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan, design,  
 10 construct, furnish and equip a west side indoor sports facility  
 11 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for  
 12 the original purpose but is changed to acquire land for and to  
 13 plan, design, construct, improve, furnish and equip an indoor  
 14 sports complex near the Jennifer Riordan spark kindness sports  
 15 complex in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of  
 16 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2026.

17           **SECTION 23. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE SPORTS COMPLEX**  
 18 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO INDOOR SPORTS COMPLEX--EXTEND TIME--  
 19 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the  
 20 appropriation to the local government division originally  
 21 authorized in Subsection 121 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of  
 22 Laws 2019 and reauthorized in Laws 2023, Chapter 203, Section  
 23 31 to acquire land and rights of way for and to plan, design,  
 24 construct, furnish and equip an indoor sports complex in the  
 25 west side area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be

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1 expended for the original purpose but is changed to acquire  
2 land for and to plan, design, construct, improve, furnish and  
3 equip an indoor sports complex near the Jennifer Riordan spark  
4 kindness sports complex in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.  
5 The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2026.

6           **SECTION 24. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE INDOOR RECREATION**  
7 **COMPLEX CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO INDOOR SPORTS COMPLEX**  
8 **IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended  
9 balance of the appropriation to the local government division  
10 in Subsection 141 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to  
11 acquire land and to plan, design, construct, improve and equip  
12 an indoor recreation complex on the west side of Albuquerque in  
13 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original  
14 purpose but is changed to acquire land for and to plan, design,  
15 construct, improve, furnish and equip an indoor sports complex  
16 near the Jennifer Riordan spark kindness sports complex in  
17 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is  
18 extended through fiscal year 2026.

19           **SECTION 25. JOAN JONES COMMUNITY CENTER IMPROVEMENT--**  
20 **EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for  
21 the local government division project originally authorized in  
22 Subsection 36 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 and  
23 reauthorized in Laws 2022, Chapter 52, Section 24 to plan,  
24 design, construct, expand, equip and furnish phase 2  
25 improvements to the Joan Jones community center in Albuquerque

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1 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

2           **SECTION 26. KIRTLAND PARK MURAL REPAIR--CHANGE TO**  
3 **KIRTLAND PARK RENOVATION--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance  
4 of the appropriation to the local government division in  
5 Subsection 79 of Section 28 of Chapter 199 of Laws 2023 to  
6 plan, design, construct, repair and restore a mural on the  
7 grounds of Kirtland park and the Thomas Bell community center  
8 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for  
9 the original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct,  
10 renovate and equip Kirtland park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
11 county.

12           **SECTION 27. ALBUQUERQUE CRESTVIEW BLUFF OPEN SPACE AREA**  
13 **CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
14 expenditure for the local government division project  
15 originally authorized in Subsection 5 of Section 34 of Chapter  
16 277 of Laws 2019 and reauthorized in Laws 2022, Chapter 52,  
17 Section 17 to acquire property for and to plan, design,  
18 construct and equip the Crestview bluff open space area, parks  
19 and trails in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended  
20 through fiscal year 2026.

21           **SECTION 28. SAN JOSE NEIGHBORHOOD SOUND WALL**  
22 **CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO SOUTH SAN JOSE PARK RENOVATION--CHANGE**  
23 **AGENCY--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the  
24 appropriation to the department of transportation in Subsection  
25 26 of Section 33 of Chapter 199 of Laws 2023 to plan, design

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1 and construct a sound wall in the San Jose neighborhood in  
2 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the  
3 original purpose but is appropriated to the local government  
4 division to plan, design, construct, renovate, expand and equip  
5 south San Jose park in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

6 SECTION 29. ALBUQUERQUE SAN JOSE NEIGHBORHOOD SOUND WALL  
7 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO SOUTH SAN JOSE PARK RENOVATION--CHANGE  
8 AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended  
9 balance of the appropriation to the department of  
10 transportation in Subsection 18 of Section 33 of Chapter 138 of  
11 Laws 2021 to plan, design and construct a sound wall in the San  
12 Jose neighborhood in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not  
13 be expended for the original purpose but is appropriated to the  
14 local government division to plan, design, construct, renovate,  
15 equip and expand south San Jose park in Albuquerque in  
16 Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is extended through  
17 fiscal year 2026.

18 SECTION 30. ALBUQUERQUE PROTON BEAM CANCER TREATMENT  
19 FACILITY CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO SURGICAL CENTER--GENERAL  
20 FUND.--The unexpended balance of the local government division  
21 project in Subsection 106 of Section 28 of Chapter 199 of Laws  
22 2023 to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a proton  
23 beam cancer treatment facility in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
24 county shall not be expended for the original purpose but is  
25 changed to plan, design, construct, acquire, furnish and equip

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1 a surgical center for a clinically integrated health care  
2 network in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

3 SECTION 31. ALBUQUERQUE TAYLOR RANCH LIBRARY IMPROVEMENT  
4 AND COMMUNITY ROOM CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX  
5 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government  
6 division project in Subsection 118 of Section 35 of Chapter 81  
7 of Laws 2020 to plan, design, construct, renovate, expand and  
8 make improvements, including a community room, to the Taylor  
9 Ranch library in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended  
10 through fiscal year 2026.

11 SECTION 32. UNSER MUSEUM CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO  
12 CONSTRUCT A WEST SIDE SPRAY PAD--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended  
13 balance of the appropriation to the local government division  
14 in Subsection 133 of Section 28 of Chapter 199 of Laws 2023 to  
15 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip the Unser museum in  
16 the area of Central avenue and Unser boulevard in Albuquerque  
17 in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original  
18 purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct and equip a  
19 spray pad on the west side in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

20 SECTION 33. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE SPORTS COMPLEX  
21 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
22 expenditure for the local government division project in  
23 Subsection 124 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
24 acquire land and to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip  
25 an indoor sports complex near the Jennifer Riordan spark

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1 kindness sports complex in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is  
2 extended through fiscal year 2026.

3 SECTION 34. ALBUQUERQUE YOUTH TEMPORARY HOUSING FACILITY  
4 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
5 expenditure for the local government division project in  
6 Subsection 126 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
7 plan, design, construct, renovate, purchase and equip a  
8 facility to provide temporary housing for youth in Albuquerque  
9 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

10 SECTION 35. ATRISCO LAND GRANT MONUMENT AND MEMORIAL PARK  
11 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
12 expenditure for the local government division project in  
13 Subsection 9 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to  
14 acquire land and to plan, design and construct an Atrisco land  
15 grant monument and memorial plaza park in the Atrisco community  
16 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2026.

17 SECTION 36. ALBUQUERQUE SPORTS AND CULTURAL CENTER  
18 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO BALLOON FIESTA PARK IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND  
19 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the local  
20 government division project in Subsection 116 of Section 35 of  
21 Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to acquire land for and to plan, design  
22 and construct phase 1 of a sports and cultural center,  
23 including art exhibits, public outdoor spaces, retail and
