2 REQUESTING THAT THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE SENATE BE MADE 3 AVAILABLE TO VIEWERS AND LISTENERS VIA THE INTERNET. 4 5 WHEREAS, legislative proceedings in more than forty 6 states across the country are available to the public via the 7 internet, bringing public policy debates and "democracy in action" into the living rooms of citizens and the classrooms 8 9 of students; and 10 WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature showed its support 11 for streaming its proceedings to the citizens it represents 12 by appropriating seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for 13 that purpose in 2005; and 14 WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislative council, at its 15 January 14, 2008 meeting, declined to direct staff to issue a 16 request for proposals to solicit bids so that webcasting 17 could begin; and

18 WHEREAS, a majority of the members of the senate have19 expressed support for webcasting senate proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative council service be
requested to proceed as expeditiously as possible with the
necessary arrangements and contracts to ensure that the
proceedings of the senate will be streamed on the internet
beginning in 2009; and
