18	A. Each public post-secondary educational
19	institution shall have a consistent, institutionwide leave
20	policy that does not discriminate among full-time employees.
21	All nonexempt full-time employees shall receive the same number
22	of paid holidays and shall accrue annual or other leave at the
23	same rate; provided that the institution may adopt a
24	progressive leave accrual policy based on longevity or
