House Joint Memorial 52 recognizes the life of Don Haskins, his contributions to improving college basketball, and his record of victories as a basketball coach.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

House Joint Memorial 52 makes no appropriations.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

House Joint Memorial 52 specifically cites Coach Haskins' pioneering achievement in opening the doors to college athletics for African-American basketball players, his recruiting efforts to improve the quality of collegiate basketball in New Mexico, and his seven hundred nineteen victories on the court.

The memorial further resolves to send copies to Coach Haskins' wife, Mary; their sons; the president of the University of Texas at El Paso; the El Paso City Council; the Texas Sports Hall of Fame; the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame; and the Texas Legislature.
