Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 33 requests that the New Mexico Legislative Council create an interim Veterans' and Military Affairs Committee to work with the Department of Veterans' Services, the Department of Military Affairs and related agencies to make recommendations for legislative initiatives to address findings of the committee. This memorial requests that the recommendations be developed by November 30, 2009.
