#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 95 requests that the Legislative Council appoint a Legislative interim information technology and telecommunications oversight committee to study the regulation of telecommunications companies during the interim and present policy recommendation for the fair and equitable regulation of all telecommunication companies.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Although the memorial has no appropriation, implementing the directives contained in this bill would have a minimal administrative impact including per diem, mileage, staff time, and appropriate supporting resources.
