SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 29 voids general fund projects authorized in previous years, but authorizes replacing the funding with proceeds from long-term or short-term (sponge) senior severance tax bonds for viable general fund projects.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Bill 29 voids 243 general fund projects totaling approximately \$136.1 million authorized in previous years and reverts the dollars to the general fund. The bill further authorizes severance tax bonds to be issued for the purpose of funding the viable general fund projects. The 136.1 million of swaps would count against senior net severance tax bond capacity leaving

approximately \$25.5 million remaining to be appropriated in the 2010 regular session.

Current estimates place combined senior severance tax bond capacity at \$299.9 million. This number is made up of approximately \$160 million in long-term senior severance tax bonds and \$139.9 million of short-term (sponge) senior severance tax notes. **Depending on the general fund project to be swapped, proceeds from the issuance of both long-term senior severance tax bonds and short-term (sponge) severance tax bonds could be used.** The State Board of Finance would ultimately decide which combination of long-term and short-term (sponge) severance tax bonds could be used. The State Board of both long-term and short-term (sponge) proceeds can be used for these swaps, current capacity estimates are sufficient to prudently carryout this transaction.

Section 1 provides for voiding previous years general fund appropriations and would then revert back to the general fund.

Section 2 authorizes the Board of Finance to issue and sell senior severance tax bonds in an amount not to exceed the total amount voided in Section 1 of the bill.

Section 3 provides for the expenditure of severance tax bond proceeds for the projects voided in Section 1.

Section 4, subsections A and B transfers \$51.6 million from the public school capital outlay fund to the general fund for the purpose of addressing solvency. The money transferred represents the remaining portion of the amount of the general fund appropriation made in Laws 2006, Chapter 111, Section 66 that was allocated to school districts for the state share of projects but that has not yet been expended.

Section 5 provides for the appropriation of funds from severance tax bond capacity to the public school capital outlay fund for the purpose of replacing funds transferred in Section 4.

Section 6 provides for an emergency clause. **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

The majority of projects reviewed for reversion to the general fund and substituted for severance tax bond capacity were identified from a listing of projects reviewed by LFC staff and state and local government entities. (See Attachment)

Senate Bill 29 contains an emergency clause. In order for bonds to be issued relating to this legislation at the next State Board of Finance sale, it was imperative this legislation retain its emergency clause. Without the emergency clause, the bill would become effective in January, 2010 after the State Board of Finance has sold bonds in December, 2009. The bond sale would then have to be postponed until the June, 2010 Board of Finance severance tax bond issuance.

COMPANIONSHIP

The proposed legislation is related to House Bill 28 however, there are some significant differences. House Bill 28 authorizes the use of \$140 million in senior short-term (sponge) bond proceeds and supplemental short-term (sponge) bond proceeds to restore prior year general fund capital outlay allotments. This would decrease net senior severance tax bond capacity by approximately \$98.5 million and net supplemental severance tax bond capacity (proceeds of which are appropriated to the Public School Capital Outlay Council) by approximately \$41.5 million. The proceeds from such bonds would be used to reimburse general fund projects for prior year capital outlay expenditures. However, upon arrival to the general fund these monies would not be deposited into capital project accounts for the specific projects, but would instead be deposited directly into the general fund most likely into the general appropriation account. Therefore, the practical effect is that these bond proceeds will be used directly to finance operational expenditures.

Senate Bill 29 by contrast, does not reimburse or restore any previous capital expenditures, but instead simply switches select current general fund capital outlay projects to a different revenue source in order to aide general fund solvency. The swap approach has precedent in the use of bond proceeds to address general fund deficits and was one of the approaches used during the FY09 regular session to facilitate general fund solvency. Furthermore, Senate Bill 29 leaves supplemental severance tax bond capacity untouched from the previously estimated level of \$141.5 million in FY10. This money will be used to fund awards from the Public School Capital Outlay Council for public school capital outlay projects throughout the state.
