AN ACT

RELATING TO CONCEALED HANDGUNS; PROVIDING THAT A JUDGE'S
CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSE IS VALID IN A COURT FACILITY WHERE
THE JUDGE WORKS OR IS DESIGNATED TO WORK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 29-19-11 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
Chapter 255, Section 11) is amended to read:

"29-19-11. VALIDITY OF LICENSE IN A COURTHOUSE OR COURT
FACILITY.--A concealed handgun license shall not be valid in a
courthouse or court facility, unless:

A. carrying concealed handguns is authorized by the
presiding judicial officer for that courthouse or court
facility; or

B. the concealed handgun license belongs to a judge
who works or is designated to work in the courthouse or court

2 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
3 provisions of this act is July 1, 2013.
