18	"66-8-114. CARELESS DRIVING
19	A. [Any] A person operating a vehicle on the
20	highway shall give [his] <u>the person's</u> full time and entire
21	attention to the operation of the vehicle.
22	B. [Any person who operates] <u>Careless driving</u>
23	consists of operating a vehicle in a careless, inattentive or
24	imprudent manner without due regard for the width, grade,
25	curves, corners, traffic, weather and road conditions and all

1	other attendant circumstances. <u>Whoever commits careless</u>
2	<u>driving</u> is guilty of a misdemeanor <u>as provided in Section</u>
3	<u>66-8-7 NMSA 1978.</u>
4	C. Whoever commits careless driving that results in
5	death or great bodily harm to another person is guilty of a
6	misdemeanor and shall be punished in accordance with the
7	provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.
8	D. As used in this section, "great bodily harm"
9	means an injury to a person that creates a high probability of
10	death, that causes serious disfigurement or that results in
11	permanent loss or impairment of the function of any member or
12	organ of the body."
13	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
14	provisions of this act is July 1, 2013.
