SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Judiciary Committee Substitute for House Bill 107 provides that any municipality with a population of less than three thousand according to the most recent federal decennial census may transfer funds generated through the imposition of corrections and misdemeanor traffic penalty assessment fees to the municipality's general fund provided the amount of the fund balances is in excess of the need for those fund balances during the next fiscal year.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Because this is a fee imposed by municipal courts to support municipal detention facilities, there will be no impact on state any funds.

According to the New Mexico Municipal League, "many municipalities have accumulated large amounts of money in this fund. This bill would provide an additional use to which these funds could be applied".
