### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Resolution 1 resolves to notify the federal government to cease and desist, effective immediately, mandates beyond the scope of constitutionally delegated powers, federal laws directing states to comply under threat of civil or criminal penalties or sanctions or loss of federal funding be prohibited or repealed, and copies of the resolution be sent to the President of the United States, President of the US Senate and Speaker of the US House, and to the speaker and president of the senate of each state legislature.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Costs of under \$1.0 are estimated to prepare the letters and pay postage to send out the resolution to the required addressees. Existing staff would perform the administrative tasks.

### TECHNICAL ISSUES

Copies should also be sent to members of the New Mexico congressional delegation. Page 2, line 20, strike the period after “States” and add “and to members of the New Mexico congressional delegation.”
