#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 65 declares Connell's Cabin in the Village of Terrero in San Miguel County to be a New Mexico treasure.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

According to the memorial, Connell's Cabin was originally built and used by the Forest Service before being used as part of the Terrero lead and zinc ore mine. It was subsequently owned by A.J. Connell, the original director of Los Alamos Ranch School which later became the Los Alamos National Laboratory.
