- (1) for a first offense, guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978; and
- (2) for a second or subsequent offense, guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.
- C. If leaving a child unattended in a motor vehicle results in injury requiring hospitalization or the death of the child, it shall be deemed prima facie evidence of abuse of the child under Section 30-6-1 NMSA 1978."
- **SECTION 2.** EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
