BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of The Livestock Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] IDENTIFICATION AND MONITORING OF ANIMALS
REJECTED AT THE MEXICAN BORDER.--The board shall identify and
monitor animals that have been rejected for slaughter for human
consumption at the Mexican border."
