 $\underline{B.}$ Whoever commits enticement of child is guilty of a [$\underline{misdemeanor}$]:

(1) fourth degree felony if the child is at least thirteen but under sixteen years of age; or

(2) third degree felony if the child is under thirteen years of age."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
