16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 30-1-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,
18	Chapter 303, Section 1-8, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"30-1-8. TIME LIMITATIONS FOR COMMENCING PROSECUTIONA

9	F. for the crime of tampering with evidence, within

14	crime was committed;
15	[F.] <u>H.</u> for a felony pursuant to Section 7-1-71.3,
16	7-1-72 or 7-1-73 NMSA 1978, within five years from the time the
17	crime was committed; provided that for a series of crimes
18	involving multiple filing periods within one calendar year, the
19	limitation shall begin to run on December 31 of the year in
20	which the crimes occurred;
21	$[G_{\bullet}]$ <u>I.</u> for an identity theft crime pursuant to
22	Section 30-16-24.1 NMSA 1978, within five years from the time
23	the crime was discovered;
24	$[H_{\bullet}] \underline{J}_{\bullet}$ for any crime not contained in the Criminal
25	Code or where a limitation is not otherwise provided for,
