11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A FEASIBILITY AND MARKET STUDY FOR
12 A NATIONAL NAVAJO CODE TALKERS MUSEUM AND VETERANS CENTER.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars
16 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the Indian
17 affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2015 to
18 conduct a feasibility and market study regarding visitors and
19 traffic at a national Navajo code talkers museum and veterans
20 center located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or
21 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2015
22 shall revert to the general fund.
