I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

**EAST CULPEPPER FLATS DOMESTIC WCA IMPROVE**

twenty-three thousand five hundred dollars (\$23,500) to design, construct and equip water system improvements, including security fencing and road base, for the east Culpepper Flats domestic water consumers association in San Juan county

**UPPER LA PLATA DWC & MSW COOP WATER SYS IMPROVE**

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to the water system and supply lines for the upper La Plata domestic water consumers and mutual sewage works cooperative in San Juan county

**VALLEY ACRES WASTEWATER SYS IMPROVE & LOAN REPAY**

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements and to repay a clean water state revolving loan fund project for improvements to the Valley Acres wastewater system in Kirtland in San Juan county

**FARMINGTON WATER SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVE**

six million one hundred thousand dollars (\$6,100,000) to plan, design and construct water system infrastructure improvements in Farmington in San Juan county

**FARMINGTON CIVIC CENTER MTG ROOMS/THEATER**

three million six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip meeting rooms and theater stage space at the civic center in Farmington in San Juan county

### FARMINGTON NORTH FOOTHILLS FIRE STATION # 7

four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip fire station number 7 in the north foothills area of Farmington in San Juan county

### FARMINGTON PORTER ARROYO RETENTION FACILITY

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct the Porter arroyo retention facility in Farmington in San Juan county

### EAST AZTEC ARTERIAL ROUTE CONSTRUCT

six million one hundred thousand dollars (\$6,100,000) to construct the east Aztec arterial route in Aztec in San Juan county

### PINON HILLS BLVD EXTENSION AND BRIDGE-FARMINGTON

nineteen million dollars (\$19,000,000) to plan, design and construct the Pinon Hills boulevard extension and bridge to connect New Mexico highway 516 to Crouch mesa in Farmington in San Juan county
