four hundred forty-six thousand nine hundred eighty-five dollars (\$446,985) to plan, design and construct improvements and repairs to the center for contemporary arts in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

MUSEUM OF INDIAN ARTS AND CULTURE EXHIBIT

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase, install and equip a permanent exhibition at the museum of Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

- to the first judicial district court

1ST JUDICIAL DIST COURTHOUSE INFO TECH

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for the first judicial district courthouse in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

1ST JUDICIAL DIST COURTHOUSE OUTDOOR SEATING

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to purchase and install outdoor public seating at the first judicial district courthouse in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

NM SCHL FOR THE ARTS REAL PROPERTY PURCHASE

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to purchase a portion of the department of transportation's real property located on Alta Vista street to provide a permanent campus for the New Mexico school for the arts, contingent upon an equal match from private donations, in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) to plan, design, construct and equip the south New Mexico highway 14 senior and community center in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE CO WOMEN'S HEALTH BUILDING RENOVATE

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to design and construct renovations to the women's health building in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE AIRPORT BUILDING EXPAND

one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) to plan, design, construct and equip the Santa Fe airport building expansion in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE DATA CENTER GENERATOR

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, purchase and install a backup generator for the Santa Fe data center in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE FORT MARCY REC CTR IMPROVE

five hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$553,000) to design and construct improvements to the Fort Marcy recreational center in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE MEAL PROGRAM BUILDING RENOVATE/EXPAND

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to purchase and install information technology and related infrastructure and to plan, design, construct, renovate, expand, furnish and equip a city-owned building that houses a meal program serving a low-income, homebound, chronically or terminally ill population in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

SANTA FE MOUNTAIN CENTER TRAINING FACILITY

sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan, design, construct, equip, furnish and upgrade the urban adventure and training center at the Santa Fe mountain center in Santa Fe county

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate and equip improvements to the police department evidence room, records building and professional standards building in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

three hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$370,000) to design and construct interior and exterior improvements to the recreation center at Salvador Perez park in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a regional park in southwest Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to construct the water history museum and restrooms in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

five million one hundred thousand dollars (\$5,100,000) for improvements to the Santa Fe watershed, including thinning, in Santa Fe county
