A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is 6 7 enacted to read: "TEXTING WHILE DRIVING .--8 A person shall not read or view a text message 9 Α. or manually type on a handheld mobile communication device 10 for any purpose while driving a motor vehicle, except to 11 summon medical or other emergency help or unless that device 12 is an amateur radio and the driver holds a valid amateur 13 radio operator license issued by the federal communications 14 15 commission. Β. The provisions of this section shall not be 16 construed as authorizing the seizure or forfeiture of a 17 handheld mobile communication device. Unless otherwise 18 provided by law, the handheld mobile communication device 19 20 used in the violation of the provisions of this section is not subject to search by a law enforcement officer during a 21 traffic stop made pursuant to the provisions of this section. 22 C. As used in this section: 23 "driving" means being in actual physical 24 (1)control of a motor vehicle on a highway or street and 25

includes being temporarily stopped because of traffic, a traffic light or stop sign or otherwise, but "driving" excludes operating a motor vehicle when the vehicle has pulled over to the side of or off of an active roadway and has stopped at a location in which it can safely remain stationary; 6

"handheld mobile communication device" (2)7 8 means a wireless communication device that is designed to receive and transmit text or image messages, but "handheld 9 mobile communication device" excludes global positioning or 10 navigation systems, devices that are physically or 11 electronically integrated into a motor vehicle and 12 voice-operated or hands-free devices that allow the user to 13 compose, send or read a text message without the use of a 14 hand except to activate, deactivate or initiate a feature or 15 function; and 16

(3) "text message" means a digital 17 communication transmitted or intended to be transmitted 18 between communication devices and includes electronic mail, 19 an instant message, a text or image communication and a 20 command or request to an internet site; but "text message" 21 excludes communications through the use of a computer-aided 22 dispatch service by law enforcement or rescue personnel." 23

B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.

C. When an alleged violator of a penalty
assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in
lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon
later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment
established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor
and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence
shall not exceed ninety days.

D. The penalty assessment for speeding in

violation of Paragraph (4) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.

E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.\_\_\_\_\_\_ SB 19
