SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 274 appropriates \$580 thousand to PED to establish a parent advocacy project to enhance parent support of failing students in Albuquerque Public Schools.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill's appropriation of \$580 thousand is a recurring expense to the General Fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance shall not revert.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The executive budget request includes \$1.5 million for a "Parent Portal" which has a purpose similar to HB 274, i.e. increasing parental support of students. The LFC's FY15 recommendation does not appropriate funds for the "Parent Portal."
