SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Children's Cancer Fund of New Mexico was established in 1972 to help children with cancer and their families cope with the emotional and financial needs of living with cancer. The organization supports New Mexico families by providing them with transportation and food vouchers, emergency assistance with day-to-day living expenses, and scholarship assistance to students who been treated for cancer in NM.
