SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Community colleges play an important role in local, regional, and statewide efforts in literacy training, work force development, economic development, and welfare reform. New Mexico community colleges educate and train over 60 percent of the state's total higher education undergraduate enrollment. There were 18 nominated community college all-state academic teams in NM.
