FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

SM 80 states this year's senate basketball team, despite being the upper chamber and having superior talent and good looks, has not won as many of the annual house versus senate basketball games.

Lieutenant Governor Sanchez is truly an athletic competitor and has a legendary basketball career, from the playgrounds of Albuquerque, through middle and high school, and even as a key contributor on the 2001 and 2002 house basketball team, connecting on several house versus senate games he played in. The memorial formally drafts Lieutenant Governor Sanchez as a member of the basketball team; and urges him to begin reporting to team practices, strategy sessions and scrimmages as soon as possible.
