## A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3 OF ARTICLE 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO REQUIRE THAT THE STATE AUDITOR BE A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT LICENSED IN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 5, Section 3 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"No person shall be eligible to any office specified in [Section One, hereof] Article 5, Section 1 of this constitution unless [he be] the person is a citizen of the United States, at least thirty years of age, nor unless [he] the person shall have resided continuously in New Mexico for five years next preceding [his] the person's election; nor to the office of attorney general, unless [he be] the person is a licensed attorney of the supreme court of New Mexico in good standing;
