AN ACT

RELATING TO GAME AND FISH; AMENDING A SECTION OF CHAPTER 17  
NMSA 1978 TO PROVIDE A PENALTY ASSESSMENT OPTION FOR A MINOR  
VIOLATION OF HUNTING AND FISHING INFRACTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 17-2-10.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995,  
Chapter 177, Section 1) is amended to read:

"17-2-10.1. GAME AND FISH PENALTY ASSESSMENT  
MISDEMEANORS--DEFINITION--SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--

A. As used in Chapter 17 NMSA 1978, "penalty  
assessment misdemeanor" means a violation of any of the  
following listed sections of the NMSA 1978 for which the listed  
penalty assessment is established:

12                    B. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment  
13 misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a  
14 notice of penalty assessment, no fine imposed upon later  
15 conviction shall exceed the penalty assessment established for  
16 the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor.

17                    C. With the penalty assessment collected for each  
18 penalty assessment misdemeanor pursuant to this section, there  
19 shall be assessed and collected the cost of the appropriate  
20 license and validation that the violator failed to produce.  
21 Upon presentation of proof of payment of the penalty  
22 assessment, the director of the department of game and fish  
23 shall issue the appropriate license and validation."
