17	SECTION 1. Section 59A-22-32 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984,
18	Chapter 127, Section 454, as amended) is amended to read:

21	A. Within the area and limits of coverage offered
22	an insured and selected by the insured in the application for
23	insurance, the right of a person to exercise full freedom of

1 [(7)] (8) "certified nurse-midwife" means a 2 person licensed by the board of nursing as a registered nurse and who is registered with the public health division of the 3 department of health as a certified nurse-midwife; 4 [(8)] (9) "registered lay midwife" means a 5 person who practices lay midwifery and is registered as a 6 7 registered lay midwife by the public health division of the department of health; and 8 9 [(9)] (10) "registered nurse in expanded practice" means a person licensed by the board of nursing as a 10 registered nurse approved for expanded practice pursuant to the 11 12 Nursing Practice Act as a certified nurse practitioner, certified registered nurse anesthetist, certified clinical 13 14 nurse specialist in psychiatric mental health nursing or clinical nurse specialist in private practice and who has a 15 master's degree or doctorate in a defined clinical nursing 16 [speciality] specialty and is certified by a national nursing 17 organization. 18 19 [C.
