15	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION One million twenty-four
16	thousand dollars (\$1,024,000) is appropriated from the general
17	fund to the children, youth and families department for
18	expenditure in fiscal years 2015 through 2020 to contract with
19	a Bernalillo county nonprofit organization for transitional
20	living and recovery services for adolescents statewide. Any
21	unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
22	fiscal year 2020 shall revert to the general fund.
23	SECTION 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
24	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
