Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Resolution 13 calls for a federal constitutional convention to propose a countermand amendment to the United States Constitution. The countermand amendment would authorize the states, with a vote of three-fifths of state legislatures, to nullify and repeal a federal statute, executive order, judicial decisions, regulatory decision by a federal government agency or government mandate imposed on the states by federal law that adversely affects the interests of the states.
