SUMMARY

SM 40 establishes that New Mexico opposes the designation of any expanded wilderness or special management areas adjoining the existing Pecos wilderness. The senate memorial identifies federal wilderness designations that would impede the health of the forested area, the use of adjacent non-wilderness areas, and access to adjacent areas that host economic activities.

Copies of SM 40 are to be transmitted to the New Mexico congressional delegation, the Majority Leader of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and the President of the United States.
