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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
20	SECTION 1. Section 21-14-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1965,
21	Chapter 162, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:
22	"21-14-14. [TITLE TO PROPERTY ACQUIRED FROM] <u>USE OF</u>
23	PROCEEDS OF [BOND ISSUE] A LEVY IN A BRANCH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
24	DISTRICTPROPERTY TITLEANNUAL REPORTING, ACCOUNTING AND
25	CERTIFICATION BY BOARD OF REGENTS[All property acquired from
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1 the proceeds of a bond issue shall be taken in the name of the 2 board of education or the board of regents of the parent 3 institution. A. The proceeds of a levy in a branch community 4 college district shall be used to acquire property for the use 5 of the branch community college or to finance the operational 6 7 expenses of the branch community college. Title to property acquired from the proceeds of 8 Β. 9 a levy in a branch community college district shall be taken in the name of the branch community college board, the local 10 school boards within the branch community college district or 11 12 the board of regents of the parent institution. In the event [an independent public college entity evolves from the] that a 13 14 branch community college: (1) discontinues operations under the 15 provisions of Chapter 21, Article 14 NMSA 1978 and operates as 16 a public independent community college, the property [so] held 17 by the [board of education] branch community college board, the 18 19 <u>local school boards</u> or the board of regents of the parent 20 institution on behalf of the branch community college shall be transferred and conveyed to the governing body of the [new 21 independent] public independent community college [entity. No 22 transfer or conveyance shall take place without the express 23 approval of the board of educational finance]; or 24 (2) ceases operations, the property held by 25

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1	the branch community college board or the board of regents of
2	the parent institution on behalf of the branch community
3	college shall be transferred and conveyed to the local school
4	boards within the branch community college district and the
5	property so transferred and otherwise held by the local school
6	boards for the former branch community college shall be used
7	for local school district purposes.
8	C. By September 30 of each year, the board of
9	regents of the parent institution shall report to the secretary
10	of higher education and the legislative finance committee with:
11	(1) an accounting of the expenditure in the
12	prior fiscal year of proceeds of a levy in a branch community
13	college district; and
14	(2) a certification that the proceeds of a
15	levy in a branch community college district were used pursuant
16	to the provisions of Subsection A of this section."
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
