## AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT; PREEMPTING LOCAL LAWS, POLICIES AND RESOLUTIONS FROM REGULATING CERTAIN TERMS OF PRIVATE-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] STATE PREEMPTION--EMPLOYMENT REGULATION. -- A political subdivision of the state, including a home rule municipality, or an institution of the state shall not adopt or continue in effect a law, policy or resolution that:

- regulates or attempts to regulate the hours, scheduling or leave that a private-sector employer provides its employees; or
- requires or attempts to require a private-sector В. employer to provide an employee:
