11	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO
12	REQUIRING THAT ALL QUALIFIED ELECTORS BE REGISTERED TO VOTE
13	UNDER ANY VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM, EXCEPT FOR THOSE WHO
14	AFFIRMATIVELY CHOOSE NOT TO BE REGISTERED, AND THAT ALL
15	QUALIFIED ELECTORS WHO VOTE SHALL HAVE THEIR VOTES COUNTED.

17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. A new section of Article 7 of the constitution
19	of New Mexico is enacted to read:
20	"If the legislature requires the registration of qualified
21	electors as a requisite for voting, the state shall ensure that
22	all qualified electors are registered to vote for each
23	election, except for those who affirmatively choose not to be
24	registered, and that the vote of a qualified elector shall not
25	be excluded from being counted for failure of the state to

3 SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
4 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
5 rejection at the next general election or at any special
