14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 19-1-11 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1912,
16	Chapter 82, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"19-1-11. STATE LANDS MAINTENANCE FUNDCREATEDSTATE
18	LANDS INCOMEDISPOSITIONSTATE TRUST LANDS RESTORATION AND

20	[The] <u>A. Ninety-nine percent of the</u> income derived

B. The "state trust lands restoration and 3 4 remediation fund" is created in the state treasury. One 5 percent of the income derived from any state trust lands granted or confirmed by the Enabling Act or otherwise under the 6 7 management, care, custody and control of the commissioner of 8 public lands shall be deposited in the state trust lands 9 restoration and remediation fund; provided that the state trust lands restoration and remediation fund shall not include any 10 money required to be transferred to any permanent fund created 11 12 in Chapter 19 NMSA 1978. The state trust lands restoration and remediation fund also consists of income from investment of the 13 14 fund and money otherwise accruing to the fund. Money in the state trust lands restoration and remediation fund that exceeds 15 five million dollars (\$5,000,000) shall be distributed to the 16 trust beneficiaries in the same manner that surpluses in the 17 state lands maintenance fund are distributed. Money in the 18 19 fund shall not revert to any other fund at the end of a fiscal 20 year. The state land office shall administer the fund. Subject to legislative appropriation, expenditures may be made 21 from the state trust lands restoration and remediation fund 22 upon vouchers signed by the commissioner or the commissioner's 23 authorized representative and issued by the secretary of 24 finance and administration to administer contractual surface 25
