11	SECTION 1. A new section of the Income Tax Act is	
12	enacted to read:

16	A. An individual whose state income tax liability	
17	after application of allowable credits and tax rebates in any	
18	year is lower than the amount of money held by the department	
19	to the credit of that individual for that tax year may	
20	designate a portion of the income tax refund due to the	
21	individual to be paid to the sexual assault examination kit	
22	processing grant fund for the department of public safety to	
23	award grants to law enforcement agencies for the processing	
24	of sexual assault examination kits and to the department of

assault service providers. In the case of a joint return, both individuals must make that designation.

B. The department shall revise the state income tax form to allow the designation of a contribution in the following form:

"Sexual Assault Examination Kit Processing Grant Fund and Sexual Assault Services - Check [] if you wish to contribute a part or all of your tax refund to the Sexual Assault Examination Kit Processing Grant Fund for the processing of sexual assault examination kits and to the Department of Health for the provision of sexual assault services by sexual assault service providers. Enter here \$______ the amount of your contribution.".

14 C. Instructional materials shall provide that 15 contributions to the sexual assault examination kit 16 processing grant fund may be made directly to the department 17 of public safety and contributions to fund sexual assault 18 services by sexual assault service providers may be made 19 directly to the department of health.

D. The provisions of this section do not apply to an income tax refund subject to interception under the provisions of the Tax Refund Intercept Program Act, and a designation made pursuant to the provisions of this section to that refund is void.

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E. The department shall distribute the tax refund

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1 contributions pursuant to this section as follows: 2 (1) fifty percent to the state treasury for 3 credit to the sexual assault examination kit processing grant fund for distribution by the department of public safety to 4 5 law enforcement agencies pursuant to the sexual assault examination kit processing grant program; and 6 fifty percent to the department of 7 (2) health to fund sexual assault services provided by sexual 8 assault service providers." 9 10 SECTION 2. SEXUAL ASSAULT EXAMINATION KIT PROCESSING GRANT PROGRAM--POWERS AND DUTIES--SEXUAL ASSAULT EXAMINATION 11 KIT PROCESSING GRANT FUND CREATED.--12 13 A. As used in this section: (1) "department" means the department of 14 15 public safety; and 16 (2) "grant program" means the sexual assault examination kit processing grant program established pursuant 17 to this section. 18 Β. The department shall establish and administer a 19 grant program to award funds to state and local law 20 enforcement agencies for the processing of sexual assault 21 examination kits. 22 Grant funds may be used only for the processing C. 23 by a state or municipal crime laboratory of biological 24 evidence that was collected in relation to a sexual assault. The department: 2 shall establish: (1) 3 (a) grant program application 4 procedures; 5 (b) guidelines for the grant amounts to 6 be awarded; and criteria for evaluating grant 7 (c) 8 program applications; and may establish additional eligibility 9 (2) 10 criteria for grant program applications. Annually, on or before January 1, the 11 Ε. department shall provide a report to the taxation and revenue 12 department detailing the results and performance of the grant 13 14 program. 15 F. The "sexual assault examination kit processing grant fund" is created in the state treasury. 16 The fund consists of voluntary tax refund contributions, gifts, grants 17 and donations. Balances remaining in the fund at the end of 18 a fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund. 19 The 20 department shall administer the fund, and money in the fund is subject to appropriation by the legislature to the 21 department to administer the grant program. Disbursements 22 from the fund shall be made by warrant of the secretary of 23 finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the 24 secretary of public safety or the secretary's authorized 25

2	G. A person may make a gift or donation to the	
3	sexual assault examination kit processing grant fund through	
4	the department.	
5	SECTION 3. DELAYED REPEALSection 1 of this act is	
6	repealed effective January 1, 2023.	
7	SECTION 4. APPLICABILITYThe provisions of Section 1	
8	of this act apply to taxable years beginning on or after	
9	January 1, 2017	
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
