RELATING TO OIL AND GAS; AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE LPG AND CNG

ACT TO DEFINE "LIQUEFIED NATURAL GASES" AND "LNG"; PROVIDING

A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 70-5-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1947, Chapter 214, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"70-5-1. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the LPG and CNG Act:

- A. "liquefied petroleum gases", "LPG" or "LP gas" means any material that is composed predominantly of any of the following hydrocarbons or mixtures of them: propane, propylene, butanes (normal butane or iso-butane) and butylenes;
- B. "compressed natural gases", "CNG", "liquefied natural gases" and "LNG" means mixtures of hydrocarbon gases, vapors or liquids consisting principally of methane that has been compressed for vehicular fuel;
- C. "product" or "products" of liquefied petroleum gases or compressed natural gases are considered to be liquefied petroleum gases or compressed natural gases, respectively;
- D. "qualified instructor" means a qualified employee or owner who has qualified by passing the required examination and performed for at least one year the work

2	E. "inspector" means a person hired by the bureau	
3	to enforce under administrative direction the laws and safety	
4	rules and regulations of the bureau with respect to the LP	
5	gas industry and the use of CNG and LNG in motor vehicles;	
6	F. "division" means the construction industries	
7	division of the regulation and licensing department;	
8	G. "bureau" means the liquefied petroleum and	
9	compressed gas bureau of the division; and	
10	H. "commission" means the construction industries	
11	commission."	
12	SECTION 2. Section 70-5-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1947,	
13	Chapter 214, Section 22, as amended) is amended to read:	
14	"70-5-21. MISDEMEANORAny person violating any	
15	provision of the LPG and CNG Act or the rules, regulations or	
16	orders of the bureau or the commission issued pursuant to that	
17	act is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished pursuant	
18	to Subsection A of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978."	SB 336
