SUMMARY

Synopsis of SRC Substitute

The Senate Rules Committee substitute for Senate Bill 515 appropriates \$300 thousand from the general fund to VSD to sponsor an educational and restorative program focusing on agriculture, technology, and business for New Mexico combat veterans and community members.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$300 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY18 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

VSD stated that they do not currently operate this type of program and would have to partner with a non-profit to develop such a program. The Federal Government defines "combat veteran" in Title 38, United States Code (U.S.C.), Section 1710(e)(1)(D) as "a veteran who served on active duty in a theater of combat operations during a period of war".
