AN ACT

RELATING TO NURSING; ENACTING NEW SECTIONS OF THE NURSING PRACTICE ACT; REQUIRING THE BOARD OF NURSING TO ADOPT INTERSTATE COMMISSION OF NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT ADMINISTRATORS RULES RELATED TO THE PRACTICE OF NURSING FOR THE RULES TO BE EFFECTIVE IN NEW MEXICO; ALLOWING FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION OF INTERSTATE COMMISSION OF NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT ADMINISTRATORS RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Nursing Practice Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] ADOPTED RULES OF INTERSTATE COMMISSION OF NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT ADMINISTRATORS.--No rule adopted by the interstate commission of nurse licensure compact administrators that affects the practice of nursing in this state shall be

3 SECTION 2. A new section of the Nursing Practice Act is

6 NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT ADMINISTRATORS.--All agendas, minutes,
7 reports and rulemaking records of the interstate commission of
8 nurse licensure compact administrators shall be filed by the
9 state compact administrator with the board, subject to the
10 Inspection of Public Records Act."
