16	their daily calories at school, and for many children, food
17	served at school may be the only nutritious food they
18	regularly eat; and
19	WHEREAS, one billion five hundred million dollars
20	(\$1,500,000,000) annually in health care expenses is related
21	to obesity and diabetes;
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
23	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state
24	recognize that funding for school nutrition programs to
25	promote healthier lifestyles and academic achievement is a
