A MEMORIAL

WHEREAS, according to the United States centers for disease control and prevention, cardiovascular disease is the number-one killer of women in the United States; and

WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease kills one woman almost every eighty seconds in the United States; and

WHEREAS, about eighty percent of cardiovascular disease may be prevented; and

WHEREAS, some risk factors, such as blood pressure, smoking, cholesterol and lack of regular physical activity, can be controlled; and

WHEREAS, the American heart association's go red for women movement motivates women to learn their family histories and to meet with health care providers to determine their risks for cardiovascular diseases and stroke; and

WHEREAS, go red for women encourages women to take control of their heart health by knowing the following five measurements that can be life-changing:

A. total cholesterol;

B. high-density lipoprotein, known as HDL, or
"good cholesterol";

3	E. body mass index or "BMI";
