EXPRESSING GRATITUDE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ITS EFFORTS TO BRING SAFE, SCIENTIFIC AND COMMUNITY-APPROPRIATE METHODS OF ROADSIDE VEGETATION CONTROL TO NEW MEXICO.
