AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIME; CREATING THE CRIME OF MAKING A TERRORISTIC  
THREAT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted  
to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] MAKING A TERRORISTIC THREAT.--

A. It is unlawful for a person to make a  
terroristic threat.

B. Whoever commits making a terroristic threat is  
guilty of a fourth degree felony.

C. As used in this section, "terroristic threat"  
means a threat to commit any offense involving violence to a  
person or to property that is unequivocal, unconditional and  
specific so as to convey a gravity of purpose and the immediate

1 prospect of execution with intent to:

2 (1) cause a reaction of any type to the threat  
3 by an official or volunteer agency organized to deal with  
4 emergencies;

5 (2) place a person in fear of great bodily  
6 harm;

7 (3) prevent or interrupt the occupation or use  
8 of a building, room, place of assembly, place to which the  
9 public has access, place of employment or occupation, aircraft,  
10 automobile or other form of conveyance or other public place;

11 (4) cause impairment or interruption of public  
12 communications, public transportation, public water, a public  
13 gas or power supply or other public service; or

14 (5) influence the conduct or activities of a  
15 branch or agency of the federal government, the state or a  
16 political subdivision of the state."
