15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted
16	to read:
17	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] ILLEGALLY DISMANTLING STOLEN VEHICLES
18	PENALTY
19	A. Illegally dismantling stolen vehicles consists
20	of a person knowingly:
21	(1) owning or operating a chop shop, knowing
22	that it is a chop shop;
23	(2) transporting an unlawfully obtained motor
24	vehicle or major component motor vehicle part to or from a chop
25	shop, knowing that it is a chop shop; or

9	(f) a front or rear bumper;
10	(g) a rear quarter panel;
11	(h) a deck lid, tailgate or hatchback;
12	(i) a trunk floor pan;
13	(j) a cargo box of a pickup truck;
14	(k) a frame, or if the vehicle has a
15	unitized body, a supporting structure that serves as the frame;
16	(1) a cab of a truck;
