## A JOINT RESOLUTION

RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE SALE BY THE GENERAL SERVICES

DEPARTMENT OF FIVE EASEMENTS LOCATED WITHIN THE SAN CLEMENTE

GRANT WITHIN PROJECTED SECTIONS 31 AND 32, VALENCIA COUNTY,

NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, Section 13-6-2 NMSA 1978 provides that a state agency may sell or otherwise dispose of real property by competitive sealed bid, public auction or negotiated sale to a private person or to other entities; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 provides in pertinent part that any sale, trade or lease of real property belonging to a state agency for consideration of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more shall be subject to the ratification and approval by the state legislature prior to the sale, trade or lease becoming effective; and

WHEREAS, the real property, more particularly described below, located within the central New Mexico correctional facility (the "easement property"), is currently vacant and will be used by the public service company of New Mexico for access to its proposed St. Cecilia one hundred fifteen kilovolt transmission facility for current and future electric transmission needs; and

WHEREAS, the property for each easement is described as follows:

Map No. 20 75, and being more particularly described by New 21 Mexico State Plane Grid Bearings (NAD83 Central 22 Zone) and grid distances as follows: 23 BEGINNING at the northwest corner of the easement 24

15	Tafoya Lateral, WHENCE a found plastic cap stamped
16	"5975" bears N63°42'51"E a distance of 114.71 feet;
17	THENCE Sll°07'50"W along said westerly right-of-way
18	line of Tafoya Lateral a distance of 60.09 feet to
19	a point;
20	THENCE S20°53'08"W leaving said westerly right-of-
21	way line of Tafoya Lateral a distance of 318.62
22	feet to a point;
23	THENCE N73°43'41"W a distance of 1623.45 feet to a
24	point;
25	THENCE N83°11'52"W a distance of 409.98 feet to a

1	point on said easterly right-of-way line of Los
2	Chavez Interior Drain;
3	THENCE the following two (2) courses along said
4	easterly right-of-way line of Los Chavez Interior
5	Drain:
6	along the arc of a non-tangent curve to the left
7	having a central angle of 03°30'36", a radius of
8	150.00 feet, a chord bearing N37°10'27"E a distance
9	of 9.19 feet to and an arc distance of 9.19 feet a
10	point of tangency;
11	N35°24'58"E a distance of 76.40 feet to the POINT
12	OF BEGINNING.
13	Easement contains 188,799 sq.ft., 4.3342 acres
14	(more or less).
15	BASIS OF BEARING: The Bearings within this parcel
16	description are based on Grid Bearing (New Mexico
17	State Plane Central Zone, NAD83) between said found
18	Iron Pipe and said found rebar with plastic cap
19	stamped "5975", as bearing S79°00'01"E; and
20	WHEREAS, the general services department holds the title
21	to the property, but is not using or planning a use for it;
22	and
23	WHEREAS, the appraised loss of value of the property
24	following the transfer of the easement to the public service
25	company of New Mexico has been appraised at one hundred

1	nineteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$119,500); and
2	WHEREAS, on February 7, 2019, the general services
3	department transferred an easement on the property to the
4	public service company of New Mexico for consideration in the
5	amount of one hundred nineteen thousand five hundred dollars
6	(\$119,500);
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
8	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the sale of the easement property as
9	described above be hereby ratified and approved by the
10	legislature; and
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be
12	transmitted to the general services department
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
