11	RELATING TO AVIATION; ENACTING THE RURAL AIR SERVICE
12	ENHANCEMENT ACT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. [ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] SHORT TITLEThis act may be
16	cited as the "Rural Air Service Enhancement Act".
17	SECTION 2. [ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] PURPOSEThe provision and
18	maintenance of reliable scheduled air service to rural
19	municipalities and counties constitutes the performance of an
20	essential governmental function. The purpose of the Rural Air
21	Service Enhancement Act is to provide assistance to airlines in
22	the establishment of regional scheduled air service for rural
23	communities to and from hub airports in the southwest United
24	States through a minimum revenue guarantee for scheduled air
25	service to rural municipalities or counties.

1 SECTION 3. [NEW MATERIAL] DEFINITIONS.--As used in the 2 Rural Air Service Enhancement Act: "department" means the department of 3 Α. 4 transportation; 5 "director" means the director of the division; Β. "division" means the aviation division of the 6 C. 7 department; and "minimum revenue guarantee" means the amount of 8 D. 9 money guaranteed by a municipality or county to be earned by an 10 airline providing scheduled air services to and from that 11 municipality or county, which is the difference between the 12 minimum flight charge revenue specified in the contract between 13 the municipality or county and the airline and the amount of 14 actual flight charge revenue received by the airline that is 15 less than that contractual amount. 16 SECTION 4. [NEW MATERIAL] RURAL AIR SERVICE ENHANCEMENT 17 GRANT PROGRAM. --18 The "rural air service enhancement grant Α. 19 program" is created in the division to be administered by the 20 director. 21 The director shall: Β. 22 establish and publish deadlines and (1) 23 guidelines for the submission of grant applications; 24 develop procedures for receipt, review and (2) 25 approval of grant applications; .218973.1

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1 receive, review and approve grant (3) 2 applications; 3 monitor municipalities' and counties' use (4) of grant money by reviewing annual reports submitted to the 4 5 director to ensure that grants are used consistently with the terms of the grant awards; 6 7 establish grant reporting requirements (5) that meet the general purpose of the Rural Air Service 8 9 Enhancement Act; and 10 (6) perform other duties as necessary to carry 11 out the provisions of the Rural Air Service Enhancement Act. 12 C. Each fiscal year, competitive grants for minimum 13 revenue guarantees shall be awarded to applicants for the sole 14 purpose of funding rural air service enhancement grants. 15 The director shall award grants to applicants D. 16 through a competitive process and based upon the following 17 criteria: 18 (1)the demand for service on the proposed air 19 routes; 20 the economic impact on the municipality or (2) 21 county of the proposed new air routes; and 22 the feasibility of a common carrier (3) 23 licensed by the state servicing proposed new air routes. 24 Applicants shall meet the following minimum Ε. 25 criteria to be eligible for a grant: .218973.1 - 3 -

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1 (1) municipalities or counties shall have a minimum population of twenty thousand persons residing within a 2 3 fifty-mile radius of the airport unless the municipality or 4 county has existing scheduled air service; 5 (2)aircraft to be used to service proposed 6 new air routes served by the rural air service enhancement 7 grant program shall be twin engine turboprop aircraft; 8 routes to be served by the program shall (3) 9 be new air routes that were not served at the time the grant 10 was made; and 11 (4) minimum matching funds from a municipality 12 or county shall be: 13 ten percent if the municipality or (a) 14 county has no existing scheduled air service at the time of 15 application; and 16 fifty percent if the municipality or (b) 17 county has existing scheduled air service at the time of 18 application. 19 F. Individual grants awarded through the rural air 20 service enhancement grant program shall not: 21 exceed one million two hundred fifty (1)22 thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) per year for municipalities or 23 counties with existing scheduled air service; 24 (2) exceed one million seven hundred fifty 25 thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) per year for municipalities or .218973.1 - 4 -

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1 counties not served by existing scheduled air service; or 2 (3) be used for infrastructure improvement. 3 G. Individual grants awarded through the rural air 4 service enhancement grant program shall cover a time frame of 5 at least two years. 6 SECTION 5. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] GRANT APPLICATIONS.--A 7 municipality or county may submit an application to the 8 director for a rural air service enhancement grant. An 9 applicant shall comply with deadlines and guidelines published 10 by the director. A grant application shall include: 11 Α. a description of the facility that will serve 12 the proposed new scheduled air service; 13 an estimate of the demand for the proposed new Β. 14 scheduled air service routes; 15 identification of the air common carrier that C. 16 will service the proposed new scheduled air service routes and bracketed material] = delete 17 the aircraft to be used on the new scheduled air service 18 routes; 19 D. a description of existing scheduled air service 20 routes serving the applicant; 21 a description and schedule of the proposed new Ε. 22 scheduled air service routes to serve the applicant; 23 a justification for the new proposed scheduled F. 24 air service routes; 25 G. the requested grant amount and the amount of any .218973.1 - 5 -

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matching funds; and

H. the time frame for a commitment to subsidize the proposed new scheduled air service routes.

SECTION 6. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] RURAL AIR SERVICE ENHANCEMENT FUND--CREATED.--

A. The "rural air service enhancement fund" is created in the state treasury. All appropriations, gifts, devises, grants and donations received shall be deposited in the fund. Money in the fund is appropriated to the division for the purpose of carrying out the rural air service enhancement grant program pursuant to the provisions of the Rural Air Service Enhancement Act. Money in the fund shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year.

B. The fund shall be administered by the division. Disbursements from the fund shall be made only upon warrant drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the director or the director's designee for the purpose of carrying out the rural air service enhancement grant program pursuant to the provisions of the Rural Air Service Enhancement Act.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION.--Nine million dollars (\$9,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the aviation division of the department of transportation for expenditure in fiscal year 2022 and subsequent fiscal years for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Rural Air .218973.1 - 6 -
