AN ACT

RELATING TO PENSION SOLVENCY; REPEALING THE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE FUND AND THE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE PROGRAM FUND AND TRANSFERRING THE BALANCE OF THOSE FUNDS TO THE INCOME FUND OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ASSOCIATION; INCREASING CERTAIN EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTION RATES PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 7-1-6.61 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2017 (1st S.S.), Chapter 3, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"7-1-6.61. DISTRIBUTION--OIL AND GAS EMERGENCY SCHOOL TAX [EXCESS EXTRACTION TAXES SUSPENSE FUND] TAX STABILIZATION RESERVE . --

A. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.20 NMSA .222939.1

1978 shall be made to the [excess extraction taxes suspense fund] tax stabilization reserve in an amount as calculated pursuant to Subsection B of this section.

B. If the year-to-date amount plus the current net receipts exceeds the annual average amount, the excess shall be distributed by the taxation and revenue department to the [excess extraction taxes suspense fund. Each month the department of finance and administration shall make the calculation to determine the excess amount to be distributed] tax stabilization reserve. If there is not an excess amount, no distribution shall be made.

C. As used in this section:

- (1) "annual average amount" means the total net receipts attributable to the tax imposed pursuant to Section 7-31-4 NMSA 1978 and distributed pursuant to Section 7-1-6.20 NMSA 1978 in the immediately preceding five fiscal years, divided by five; and
- (2) "year-to-date amount" means the cumulative year-to-date net receipts attributable to the tax imposed pursuant to Section 7-31-4 NMSA 1978 and distributed to the general fund in the prior months of the current fiscal year."

- a portion of the receipts, estimated by the taxation and revenue department to be equal to the amount that the state would have received as its share of royalties in the same fiscal year if the prepayment had not been made, shall be distributed to the public school fund; and
- (2) the remainder shall be distributed to the common school permanent fund."
- SECTION 21. FUND TRANSFER. -- On the effective date of this act, the balance of the early childhood education and care fund and the early childhood education and care program fund is transferred to the income fund of the public employees retirement association.
- SECTION 22. REPEAL.--Section 6-4-27 NMSA 1978 (being Laws .222939.1

2020, Chapter 3, Section 4) is repealed.

SECTION 23. REPEAL.--Sections 9-29A-1 through 9-29A-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2020, Chapter 3, Sections 1 through 3) are repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the SECTION 24. provisions of this act is July 1, 2023.

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
