**56TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2023**

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR  
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,  
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES, CLARIFYING  
LOCATIONS AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR  
TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE  
LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section  
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds  
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been  
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax  
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or  
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously  
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is  
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been  
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax  
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the  
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--  
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section  
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation  
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period  
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed  
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not  
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in  
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the  
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the  
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation  
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed  
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date  
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this  
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general  
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A  
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the  
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs  
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a  
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo  
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the  
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2           **SECTION 3. ACEQUIA DE LOS GARCIAS Y DURANES DAM**  
3 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
4 expenditure for the interstate stream commission project in  
5 Subsection 26 of Section 33 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
6 plan, design and construct diversion dam improvements for the  
7 acequia de los Garcias y Duranes in the Medanales area in Rio  
8 Arriba county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

9           **SECTION 4. ACEQUIA DE ANTON CHICO, ACEQUIA DE TECOLOTITO**  
10 **AND ACEQUIA DE LOS RANCHITOS IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL**  
11 **FUND.--**The time of expenditure for the interstate stream  
12 commission project in Subsection 15 of Section 33 of Chapter  
13 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and construct improvements,  
14 including installation of pipe, replacement of headgates and  
15 widening and reconstruction of banks, to acequia de Anton  
16 Chico, acequia de Tecolotito and acequia de los Ranchitos in  
17 Guadalupe and San Miguel counties is extended through fiscal  
18 year 2025.

19           **SECTION 5. PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION IN BERNALILLO**  
20 **AND SANDOVAL COUNTIES--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
21 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
22 Subsection 106 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
23 acquire rights of way for and to plan, design and construct  
24 paseo del Volcan, also known as New Mexico highway 347, in  
25 Bernalillo and Sandoval counties is extended through fiscal

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1 year 2025.

2           **SECTION 6. ATRISCO DRIVE CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--**  
 3 GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the department of  
 4 transportation project in Subsection 5 of Section 40 of Chapter  
 5 277 of Laws 2019 to acquire rights of way and to plan, design  
 6 and construct a road, including drainage, off Atrisco drive  
 7 between Rosendo Garcia road and San Ygnacio road in Bernalillo  
 8 county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

9           **SECTION 7. ALBUQUERQUE ENCUESTRO CENTER RENOVATION--**  
 10 CHANGE TO PURCHASE, RENOVATE AND INSTALL A MODULAR BUILDING--  
 11 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the  
 12 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 43  
 13 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to plan, design,  
 14 construct, renovate and equip an educational and service  
 15 facility in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be  
 16 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,  
 17 design, construct, purchase, deliver, renovate, furnish, equip  
 18 and install a modular building for an education and workforce  
 19 development center in Bernalillo county.

20           **SECTION 8. ALBUQUERQUE ENCUESTRO CENTER RENOVATION--**  
 21 CHANGE TO PURCHASE, RENOVATE AND INSTALL A MODULAR BUILDING--  
 22 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the  
 23 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 60  
 24 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to plan, design,  
 25 construct, renovate, equip and furnish an education and

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1 workforce development center for low-income Spanish speakers in  
2 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the  
3 original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct,  
4 purchase, deliver, renovate, furnish, equip and install a  
5 modular building for an education and workforce development  
6 center in Bernalillo county.

7           SECTION 9. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES FACILITIES  
8 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO RENOVATE A FAMILY SERVICES FACILITY--  
9 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the  
10 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 4  
11 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to demolish an  
12 existing building and to plan, design and construct a child  
13 development and family services facility in the south valley in  
14 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original  
15 purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct, renovate,  
16 furnish, equip and landscape a family services facility in the  
17 south valley in Bernalillo county.

18           SECTION 10. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES FACILITIES  
19 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO RENOVATE FACILITY--SEVERANCE TAX  
20 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the  
21 local government division in Subsection 12 of Section 30 of  
22 Chapter 53 of Laws 2022 to demolish an existing building and to  
23 plan, design and construct a child development and family  
24 services facility in the south valley in Bernalillo county  
25 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is changed

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1 to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and  
 2 landscape a child development and family services facility in  
 3 the south valley in Bernalillo county.

4           **SECTION 11. ALBUQUERQUE NATIONAL FLAMENCO INSTITUTE**  
 5 **EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--CHANGE TO IMPROVE BERNALILLO COUNTY**  
 6 **FLAMENCO FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The  
 7 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government  
 8 division in Subsection 97 of Section 30 of Chapter 53 of Laws  
 9 2022 to equip and furnish education and performance spaces,  
 10 sound and lighting, storage and video computer technology for  
 11 performance capture and archives for the national institute of  
 12 Flamenco arts and education in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county  
 13 shall not be expended for the original purpose but is changed  
 14 to purchase equipment, appliances and information technology  
 15 and to plan, design, construct, purchase, furnish, equip and  
 16 improve buildings, infrastructure and outdoor education, arts  
 17 and performance spaces at a flamenco facility in Bernalillo  
 18 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal  
 19 year 2025.

20           **SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF FLAMENCO**  
 21 **IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO IMPROVE BERNALILLO COUNTY FLAMENCO**  
 22 **BUILDING AND PERFORMANCE SPACES--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The  
 23 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government  
 24 division in Subsection 75 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws  
 25 2021 to plan, design, construct, improve, equip and furnish

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1 buildings and infrastructure, including a café, reception  
2 space, studio, outdoor area, information technology, audio  
3 equipment and furniture, at a flamenco studio in Albuquerque in  
4 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original  
5 purpose but is changed to purchase equipment, appliances and  
6 information technology and to plan, design, construct,  
7 purchase, furnish, equip and improve buildings, infrastructure  
8 and outdoor education, arts and performance spaces at a  
9 flamenco facility in Bernalillo county.

10 SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE MEAL DELIVERY PROGRAM EQUIPMENT  
11 PURCHASE--CHANGE TO PURCHASE BERNALILLO COUNTY MEAL DELIVERY  
12 PROGRAM EQUIPMENT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance  
13 of the appropriation to the local government division in  
14 Subsection 68 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to  
15 purchase and install equipment, including freezers, ovens, a  
16 blast chiller, information technology and related equipment and  
17 infrastructure, for a homebound and special needs meal delivery  
18 program in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be  
19 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase  
20 and install equipment, including information technology and  
21 related equipment and infrastructure, cooking equipment, white  
22 goods, appliances and storage equipment, for a homebound and  
23 special needs meal delivery program in Bernalillo county.

24 SECTION 14. BERNALILLO COUNTY MOUNTAINVIEW SIDEWALKS AND  
25 DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL

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1 FUND.--The department of transportation project in Subsection 7  
 2 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and  
 3 construct sidewalks and drainage infrastructure in the  
 4 Mountainview area, including Prince street and Prosperity  
 5 avenue, in Bernalillo county may include the acquisition of  
 6 rights of way. The time of expenditure is extended through  
 7 fiscal year 2025.

8 SECTION 15. SOUTH VALLEY FAMILY SERVICES BUILDINGS

9 REDEVELOPMENT--CHANGE TO RENOVATE A SOUTH VALLEY FAMILY  
 10 SERVICES FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended  
 11 balance of the appropriation to the local government division  
 12 in Subsection 22 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
 13 plan, design, demolish and construct a phased development and  
 14 replacement of buildings and facilities for a family services  
 15 program in the south valley in Bernalillo county shall not be  
 16 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,  
 17 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and landscape a  
 18 family services facility in the south valley. The time of  
 19 expenditure for the project is extended through fiscal year  
 20 2025.

21 SECTION 16. BERNALILLO COUNTY STREET LIGHTS DISTRICT 2--

22 EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the  
 23 department of transportation project in Subsection 8 of Section  
 24 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, construct and  
 25 install street lights in county commission district 2 in

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1 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

2           SECTION 17. BERNALILLO COUNTY WEST CENTRAL FIRE STATION  
3 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
4 expenditure for the local government division project in  
5 Subsection 15 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
6 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct and equip a  
7 fire station on the west side of Bernalillo county is extended  
8 through fiscal year 2025.

9           SECTION 18. BERNALILLO COUNTY WHISPERING PINES SENIOR  
10 MEAL SITE VEHICLE PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The  
11 time of expenditure for the aging and long-term services  
12 department project in Subsection 1 of Section 4 of Chapter 277  
13 of Laws 2019 to purchase and equip a meal delivery vehicle and  
14 to make improvements to the facility at the Whispering Pines  
15 senior meal site in Bernalillo county is extended through  
16 fiscal year 2025.

17           SECTION 19. BRIDGE BOULEVARD PHASE 2 BUS SHELTERS AND  
18 MEDIAN ART IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time  
19 of expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
20 Subsection 9 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan,  
21 design and construct phase 2 improvements, including bus  
22 shelters and median art, along Bridge boulevard between Young  
23 avenue and the Riverside drain in the south valley in  
24 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

25           SECTION 20. DENNIS CHAVEZ BOULEVARD AND CONDERSHIRE DRIVE

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1 SW INTERSECTION STREET LIGHTS--CLARIFYING LOCATION--EXTEND  
2 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The location for the department of  
3 transportation project in Subsection 10 of Section 38 of  
4 Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan, design, construct, equip and  
5 install street lights at the intersection of Dennis Chavez  
6 boulevard and Condershire drive SW in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
7 county is Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is  
8 extended through fiscal year 2025.

9 SECTION 21. ESCARPMENT ROAD PAVING AND IMPROVEMENT--  
10 EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the  
11 department of transportation project in Subsection 10 of  
12 Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and  
13 construct paving and other improvements on Escarpment road on  
14 the southwest mesa in Bernalillo county is extended through  
15 fiscal year 2025.

16 SECTION 22. ISLETA BOULEVARD REHABILITATION--EXTEND  
17 TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the department  
18 of transportation project in Subsection 12 of Section 40 of  
19 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and construct the  
20 rehabilitation of Isleta boulevard SW from Muniz road to  
21 interstate highway 25 in Bernalillo county is extended through  
22 fiscal year 2025.

23 SECTION 23. MOONLIGHT DRIVE PUEBLO OF ISLETA EXTENSION--  
24 EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the  
25 department of transportation project in Subsection 39 of

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1 Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,  
2 construct and extend Moonlight drive, including arroyo  
3 stabilization and a retention pond, in the Pueblo of Isleta in  
4 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

5 SECTION 24. NEW MEXICO HIGHWAY 333 AND TABLAZON ROAD  
6 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time  
7 of expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
8 Subsection 15 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
9 acquire rights of way for and to plan, design and construct  
10 improvements at the intersection of Tablazon road and New  
11 Mexico highway 333, including realignment and road extension,  
12 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

13 SECTION 25. NEW MEXICO HIGHWAYS 314, 45 AND 317  
14 REALIGNMENT PROJECT--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of  
15 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
16 Subsection 14 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
17 plan, design and construct the New Mexico highways 314, 45 and  
18 317 realignment project to comply with road safety audit  
19 recommendations in the Pueblo of Isleta in Bernalillo county is  
20 extended through fiscal year 2025.

21 SECTION 26. SOUTH VALLEY DITCH ACCESS GATES  
22 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
23 expenditure for the interstate stream commission project  
24 originally authorized in Subsection 1 of Section 34 of Chapter  
25 81 of Laws 2020 and reauthorized to the local government

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1 division in Laws 2021, Chapter 139, Section 8 to purchase,  
 2 deliver and install materials and equipment and to plan,  
 3 design, construct, improve and equip existing and new access  
 4 control gates for ditches and acequias in the south valley area  
 5 of Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

6           **SECTION 27. SOUTH VALLEY DITCH CONTROL ACCESS GATES**  
 7 **EQUIPMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The  
 8 time of expenditure for the project originally appropriated to  
 9 the local government division in Subsection 20 of Section 34 of  
 10 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 and reauthorized in Laws 2021, Chapter  
 11 139, Section 9 to purchase, deliver and install materials and  
 12 equipment and to plan, design, construct, improve and equip  
 13 existing and new access control gates for ditches and acequias  
 14 in the south valley area of Bernalillo county is extended  
 15 through fiscal year 2025.

16           **SECTION 28. SECOND STREET SOUTHWEST ROAD AND DRAIN**  
 17 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
 18 expenditure for the department of transportation project in  
 19 Subsection 3 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan,  
 20 design and construct phase 2 improvements, including drainage,  
 21 sidewalk and improvements to comply with the federal Americans  
 22 with Disabilities Act of 1990, to Second street SW in  
 23 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

24           **SECTION 29. FOURTH STREET NW IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND**  
 25 **PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The department of

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1 transportation project in Subsection 18 of Section 40 of  
2 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and construct  
3 improvements, including sidewalk infill, accessibility features  
4 and demolition of retaining walls, on Fourth street NW in  
5 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may include the acquisition of  
6 rights of way. The time of expenditure is extended through  
7 fiscal year 2025.

8           **SECTION 30. FOURTH STREET SW IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO**  
9 **ACQUIRE RIGHTS OF WAY AND TO IMPROVE FOURTH STREET SW AND**  
10 **SIDEWALKS--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance  
11 of the appropriation to the department of transportation in  
12 Subsection 19 of Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
13 plan, design and construct street and sidewalk improvements on  
14 Fourth street SW in the Barelmas neighborhood of Albuquerque in  
15 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original  
16 purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way and to plan,  
17 design and construct street and sidewalk improvements,  
18 including sidewalk infill, accessibility features and  
19 demolition of retaining walls, on Fourth street SW in  
20 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is  
21 extended through fiscal year 2025.

22           **SECTION 31. ALBUQUERQUE WEST SIDE SPORTS COMPLEX**  
23 **CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
24 expenditure for the local government division project in  
25 Subsection 121 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
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1 acquire land and rights of way for and to plan, design,  
 2 construct, furnish and equip an indoor sports complex in the  
 3 west side area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended  
 4 through fiscal year 2025.

5 **SECTION 32. ALBUQUERQUE DAY SHELTER AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**  
 6 **SERVICES CENTER PURCHASE AND CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO CONSTRUCT**  
 7 **A DAY SHELTER AND HEALTH CENTER IN THE GIBSON HEALTH**  
 8 **HUB--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the  
 9 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 45  
 10 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,  
 11 purchase and construct a day shelter and behavioral health  
 12 services center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not  
 13 be expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,  
 14 design, purchase, construct, equip and furnish a day shelter  
 15 and behavioral health services center in the Gibson health hub  
 16 in Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is extended through  
 17 fiscal year 2025.

18 **SECTION 33. ALBUQUERQUE EMERGENCY FOOD DISTRIBUTION**  
 19 **PROGRAM PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--**  
 20 **SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local  
 21 government division project in Subsection 42 of Section 29 of  
 22 Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to purchase vehicles and equipment for  
 23 use by a food bank emergency food distribution program in  
 24 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal  
 25 year 2025.

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1           **SECTION 34. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE**  
2 PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of  
3 expenditure for the local government division project in  
4 Subsection 50 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to  
5 purchase and equip fire department vehicles for Albuquerque in  
6 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2025.

7           **SECTION 35. ALBUQUERQUE FIRE STATION 23 CONSTRUCTION--**  
8 **CHANGE TO CONSTRUCT A FIRE STATION--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The  
9 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government  
10 division in Subsection 49 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws  
11 2021 to plan, design and construct fire station 23 on the  
12 northwest mesa in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be  
13 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,  
14 design and construct a fire station on the northwest mesa in  
15 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

16           **SECTION 36. ALBUQUERQUE FOOD BUSINESS INCUBATOR AND**  
17 **KITCHEN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The time of  
18 expenditure for the local government division project in  
19 Subsection 63 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to  
20 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct, furnish, equip  
21 and install equipment for a commercial kitchen and food  
22 business incubator in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is  
23 extended through fiscal year 2025.

24           **SECTION 37. ALBUQUERQUE HOLOCAUST AND INTOLERANCE**
