SCONC/SB 464 Page 1 C. For the purposes of administering functions of the New Mexico outdoor recreation division:

- (1) "agritourism" means activities, for recreational, entertainment or educational purposes, that allow members of the public to view or enjoy rural activities, including farming activities, ranching activities and historic, cultural or natural attractions;
- (2) "ecotourism" means a form of tourism that involves visiting areas of ecological interest and is intended as a low-impact and often small-scale alternative to standard commercial tourism; and
- (3) "outdoor recreation" means a recreational activity that occurs outdoors in a natural environment, including the use of trails, the natural landscape, water or snow resources or other natural resources
